SECURITY IS LOOKING FOR RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUALS TO JOIN THE SECURITY TEAM AT BURMAN UNIVERSITY.

Burman University security runs nightly 365 days a year providing employment opportunities both during the school year as well as summer's and Christmas break as well.. Guards are responsible for responding to incidents that occur on campus. They are required to ensure buildings are secure during shift hours. This includes clearing and locking of buildings at the appropriate time, completing checks to give appropriate warnings in the event of a maintenance emergency, looking for and reporting maintenance issues, and ensuring buildings are reopened in the morning at the end of their shift.

Successful candidates will be required to:

- Complete a 40-hour course
- receive their Alberta security license from the Solicitor general
- Complete 22 hours of on-the-job training.

- Driver's license with 2 years experience.
- Previous security experience or other leadership experience.

The garden is a service in our community for people of any demographic to have space to garden and help people connect with nature and the rhythm of the seasons as well as with other gardeners, in turn, providing a place for socializing, planting and harvesting fresh produce, fresh air and exercise which improves our mental health and wellbeing.

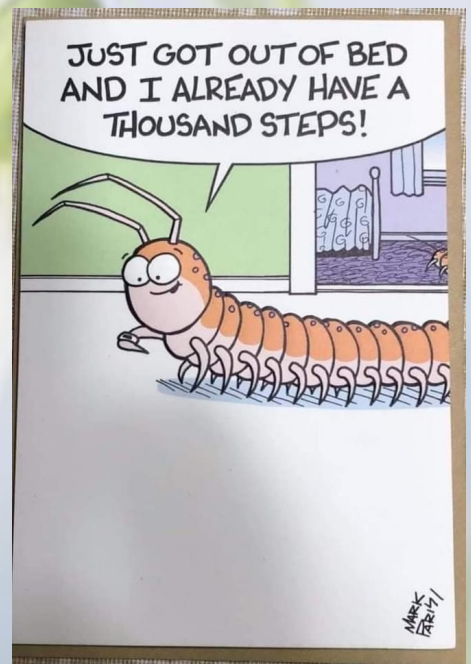
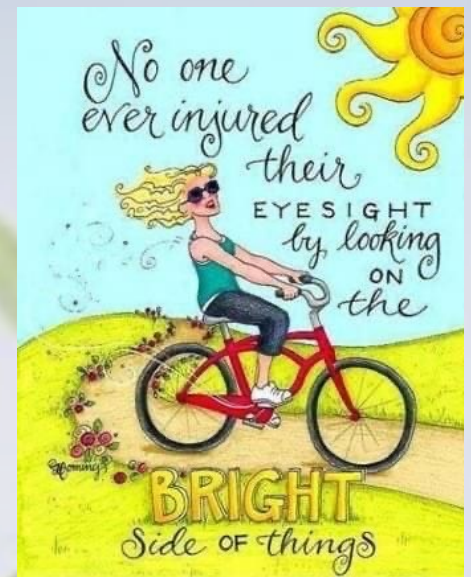
