

# Burman PE Centre Cohort Policy:

In order to use the gymnasium (the 3 badminton courts, the racquetball court, the gymnasium on the stage side of the blue curtain) you will have to belong to a Burman Sport Cohort.

- Sign up for a cohort at the PE Centre and sign an Attestation Form.
- You can only belong to **ONE** Cohort at a time. Contact R. Schafer if you wish to change Cohorts.
- You may **ONLY** play sports against people in your Cohort.
- You may only be in the gymnasium when your Cohort is scheduled to be using the gymnasium.
- You may **NOT** play sports with anyone in a different Cohort.
- You may play Individual Sports (singles badminton, singles pickleball, individual shooting - basketball) without belonging to a Cohort where physical distancing is possible.
- One on One Basketball, Doubles Badminton, Doubles Pickleball etc. is not permitted unless you are members of the same Cohort.
- Cohorts with the most members (50 is the limit) will be given more gymnasium time than smaller Cohorts.
- The Gwen Bader Fitness Centre (Weight Room) does not fall under the Cohort rules and policies.
- All users must have free gym privileges (Burman Students, Faculty, Staff and their dependents) or have a valid membership or have paid the appropriate entrance fee.
- If you wish to change Cohorts, please contact R. Schafer.
- If you are a member of a Burman Sport Cohort you may NOT be a member of another sport Cohort somewhere else (see your Attestation Form).
