

WHAT IS TECHNOLOGY FACILITATED SEXUAL VIOLENCE?

- Refers to instances of sexual abuse, violence and harassment that is perpetrated with the use of digital medial technology
- Includes: cyberstalking, cyber harassment and revenge porn

It is one of the most pervasive aspects of sexual violence today yet the least examined.

While it is a behavior that may take place online, the impacts are real. It affects 'real lives ... real humiliations and human pain is being generated"
