Cafeteria News

Regular Grab-and-Go options are available during Cafe hours. **NEW:** Pizza and Hot Dogs will be available after 7:00 pm until 9:00 pm on weekdays. The cafe closes at 7 pm on weekends.

Lunch and supper options are:

- salad bar

- pizza bar
- hot entree(s)
- convenience all day available items: (bread, bagels, packaged oatmeal and cold cereal)
- daily soup special

NEW - new entree lunch specials introduced bi-weekly

We are introducing a 4-week menu rotation. Any one entree item will be seen no more than 2x in that rotation.

Approximately 10 recipes are being added to the menu from Aramark's PRIMA Recipes. Recipe design will incorporate customization wherever possible. Students like choice.

We have added a NEW Bevi machine that offers a variety of flavoured water, as well as electrolyte- and vitamin-boosted options.

NEW - Whole Foods section for those cooking in their resident halls or homes.

NEW Staff, including our NEW Chef - He came on late in March last year and is returning to take over the kitchen. We will try to introduce each of them to campus (pictures and bios)

NEW Student Feedback Design will be tried - with the help of the student senator, a diverse group of students will sign on to taste test and score different recipes on an ongoing basis.



The Opportunity

Lacombe County is seeking a dedicated and knowledgeable **Tax Clerk** to join our Corporate Services department.

Reporting to the Manager of Assessment Services, the Tax Clerk supports property tax and assessment functions. The role combines responsibilities of tax roll maintenance and assistance to Assessment Services through maintaining tax and assessment rolls, preparing tax notices, assisting in the collection of tax payments and tax recovery procedures.

Key Responsibilities

Tax Roll Maintenance

- Develop and maintain a tax roll pursuant to the Municipal Government Act.
- Prepare Assessment & Tax notices in accordance with annual requirements. This includes:
 - Ordering blank Assessment & Tax Notices.
 - Printing, sorting and mailing notices.
 - Preparing federal and provincial grant in lieu reports.
 - Following County policy on returned notices.
- Levy all penalties and costs pursuant to established bylaws and policies, maintain the tax roll in balance with the assessment roll and the general ledger.
- Prepare reports required by the County Auditor for the annual audit process.
- Assist in the collection of tax payments and Tax Recovery procedures, including public auctions for Taxes.
- Respond to property owner and professional requests for information.
- Coordinate with the Provincial Assessor to ensure ownership information is up-to-date.

Assessment Functions

- Assist to develop and maintain the assessment roll as required to the Municipal Government Act.
- Act as administrative assistant to the Manager of Assessment Services and Assessors.
- Process Assessment & Tax Roll changes and maintain assessment balances as required to complete financial statements.
- Assist with paper and electronic file management, and record and amend information as necessary.
- Receive maps, plans, land titles, and leases to record, amend, and file as required.
- Proven ability to handle inquiries and resolve issues while maintaining confidentiality.
- Strong understanding of mandatory deadlines and effective time management practices.
